Georgia Power works to protect you

You can count on us to take the utmost precautions to secure your personal information and make you feel safe. In fact, your safety and security are our highest priority.

Here are a few reminders for avoiding scams:

- If an account becomes past due, Georgia Power will contact the customer via a prerecorded message to the primary account telephone or by letter requesting that the customer call Georgia Power to discuss the account.
- Georgia Power will never ask for a credit card or prepaid debit card number over the phone.
- Georgia Power employees do not collect payment in person and will not ask a customer to pay anywhere other than a Georgia Power business office or Authorized Payment Location.

 If a customer receives a suspicious call from someone claiming to be from Georgia Power and demanding payment to avoid disconnection, they should contact the company's 24-hour customer service line at 888-660-5890.

Georgia Power continues to work with law enforcement agencies throughout the state to identify and prosecute criminals who pose as Georgia Power employees in order to defraud customers. The company encourages customers to report scams and fraud attempts to local law enforcement and to the Federal Trade Commission at **ftccomplaintassistant.gov**.

Forget the mailbox. Sign up for Auto Pay.

Auto Pay is a free bill-payment program where you can authorize your bill amount to be automatically debited from your checking or savings account. No more stamps and having to remember to pay your bill each month. With Auto Pay, we will continue to read your meter and calculate your bill each month. You will continue to receive your bill as you normally do, but instead of "Please Pay By" being displayed on the bill, we will display the date when your bank account will be drafted for the amount of your bill.
